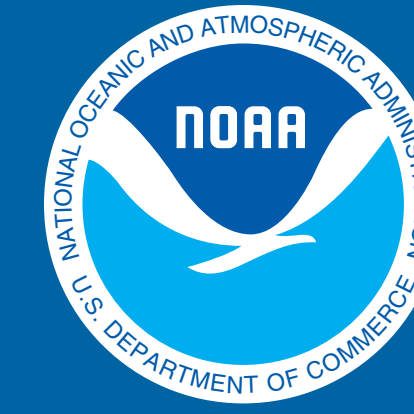

Stone Lab's Science Field Trip Program

Using Lake Erie as its living laboratory, Stone Lab has provided groups grades 4-12 and adults with one-of-a-kind, interactive science experiences for more than 35 years. Students venture out on a research vessel, scour over microscopes of Lake Erie plankton, and dissect fish straight from the lake—learning firsthand what it takes to be a Lake Erie scientist.
