COURSE DESCRIPTION

These workshops offer participants three days of place-based learning on Kelleys Island including identification of Lake Erie floating and submersed aquatic vascular plants, wetland plant identification and field instruction for conducting a Vegetation Index of Biotic Integrity (VIBI). Lectures and lab take place in classrooms at the Kelleys Island Field Station with field trips planned to various preserves owned by the State of Ohio or the Cleveland Museum of Natural History on Kelleys Island. Participants must have completed an introductory botany course or have strong working knowledge of basic botanical terminology.
